



New Committee Descriptions

ED Administration and Clinical Operations Committee (*NEW*)

The ED Administration and Clinical Operations Committee is committed to providing resources and information to SAEM members on methods that improve clinical operations within the academic emergency department. The committee shall monitor operational trends and strategies, disseminate clinical operations-related best practices, and create and promote opportunities for original research through SAEM channels. Ideally, leaders in the science of emergency and acute care delivery will comprise this committee.

Education Committee (*NEW*)

This committee replaces the Graduate Medical Education Committee. The Education Committee will provide guidance to the SAEM Board of Directors on all matters regarding undergraduate and graduate medical education. The Education Committee and its Undergraduate Medical Education (UME) and Graduate Medical Education (GME) subcommittees will be composed of leaders in medical education. In collaboration with other important SAEM entities (e.g., the Clerkship Directors in Emergency Medicine (CDEM), the Education Committee will focus on projects that advance the specialty of emergency medicine and enhance the education of medical students, residents, and fellows.

Research Directors Committee (*NEW*)

The Research Directors Committee is charged with promoting, through education, advanced training, mentorship, and ethical conduct, the role of research in advancing emergency medicine. The Research Directors Committee will explore avenues for research training and mentorship for early investigators as well as examine opportunities for enhancing the career longevity and involvement and retention of established investigators. This committee will largely be composed of thought-leading research directors. The work of this body will complement that of the Research Committee.
