Who Can Apply?

The externship is open to medical students enrolled in their 4th year of an LCME accredited school of Medicine. The student should identify as a Black, Indigenous, or Person of Color (including African or Caribbean, Latinx, Native Americans, Asian, Middle Eastern, Indian, and Pacific Island heritage) and students from the LGBTQ community.

It offers selected externs a \$750 scholarship per year for travel, lodging, and other expenses.

All interested students must apply via VSAS in addition to the URM application. Applications reviewed on a rolling basis starting May 14, 2021.
