

Case 1A

CC: Cough

HPI: 1 week history of worsening shortness of breath. Has had a “cold” for the about 2 weeks. Started dry, now productive of green sputum. Feels short of breath and this is worse at night when he tries to sleep – due to coughing. Feels generally weak and has been having subjective fevers and chills.

No travel, no incarcerations. Was hospitalized 2 months ago for appendicitis. Surgery and recovery were unremarkable.

PMH: Tonsillectomy. Appendectomy.

Meds: None

FHx: None

SHx: No tobacco. Social EtOH. No illicit.

ROS: As per HPI. No N/V/D.

Skin: **Dry no rashes or ecchymoses**

Neuro: **Eyes open.** GCS 15.
